The City of Bishop Department of Public Works is considering hiring engineering and GIS student interns during the summer of 2009.

Bishop Public Works is responsible for streets, water, sewer, building inspection and permits, and most planning in the City of Bishop. The City of Bishop has a permanent population of about 3,500 and is located in the Eastern Sierra, a remote rural part of the State of California. The City's economic base is mostly recreation and government. There are about 10 employees in Public Works.

In addition to regular operations, Public Works is responsible for about \$1 million of street improvements, \$500,000 of water improvements, and \$300,000 of sewer improvements each year. The City's Geographic Information System (GIS) is about 2 years old and is undergoing continuing development.
