

Aquatics Coordinator

The Aquatics Coordinator is responsible for the safe and efficient operations of the pool, as well as overall day-to-day operations. The aquatics coordinator is responsible for training and scheduling of all pool staff, resolving any disputes, and maintaining of pool equipment. In addition to all below mentioned certifications, it is strongly preferred that the aquatics coordinator posses current LGI certification.

Manager

Managers are responsible for shifts of guards during public swim hours. This may be in morning, during open public, or evening, as well as private pool parties. Managers oversee guards and are responsible for ensuring all guard duties are done promptly and properly. Managers may also be responsible for completing cashier's report if necessary and ensuring that all required duties are completed before leaving/closing. Managers must have all below mentioned certifications.

WSI Guard

WSI Guards must hold current WSI certification in addition to all lifeguard certifications. WSI guards are responsible for teaching of swim lessons during lesson times as well as all below mentioned lifeguard duties.

Lifeguard

Lifeguards must hold current American Red Cross or equivalent LG, CPR, and First Aid certifications. The lifeguard must also be able to demonstrate rescue techniques, procedures, and have knowledge of proper rescue equipment. In addition to primary life guarding duties, the lifeguard must participate in all routine maintenance of the pool facility.
